Arranging a group visit to Royal Tunbridge Wells? We would be happy to arrange a guided tour on a day and at a time to suit you. Tours in French and German can be arranged, subject to guide availability.

All tours start and finish at the Tourist Information Centre in the Pantiles. Cost £4 per person (minimum £60) for a one-hour tour including a glass of Chalybeate Spring water

(NB: supplement of £15 per guide for French and German tours).
